MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Grace and Peace Beloved

We celebrated Pentecost Sunday on May 28, 2023. We can rejoice in the memory of this day, for the Lord God fulfilled an awesome promise, "I will pour out my Spirit on all people." (Joel 2:28) This amazing gift was also foretold by Jesus in the Gospel of John, where Jesus says He will send another Counselor, the Spirit of Truth. (John 16: 5-15) By sending the Holy Spirit, Jesus makes available to each believer wisdom, discernment, perseverance, strength, and grace, so that we can live a life that produces the fruit of the Spirit, such as love. 
